MINUTES OF LAST MEETING: 12 June 2017. These were passed as accurate.

MATTERS ARISING:

Litter Picking – JR confirmed that the rate paid for the litter picking is a lump sum payable at the start of the new financial year and will allow the payment of the national minimum wage (£7.50 with effect from 1.4.17).

There will be a garden chest/container provided between the tap and the fence at the side of Christ Church which will contain equipment for litter picking including high visibility jackets. The litter pickers to be given the code for the door. **LM to action.**

The cleaning cart will not fit through the door therefore it will be offered to the Playing Fields Association in the first instance. **LM/JR to offer to Playing Fields Association.**

The green bin behind Morleys butchers is surplus and the Parish Council will determine where this will be located in future. **JR to confirm with Parish Council.**

Discussion regarding where the litter pickers should dispose of rubbish collected. It was agreed that the list of instructions given to the litter pickers will be circulated to the Committee for updating. Advice will be given in the instructions regarding disposal of rubbish (including any needles found whilst undertaking this duty). **LM to circulate instructions to Committee. All Committee Members to make suggestions and/or amendments to LM by 31.1.18.**

Twelve blue high visibility jackets have been purchased with the letters SVA Volunteer. Two will be placed in the chest and six will be made available to the gardening group. **JR to action.**

CORRESPONDENCE: Margrit Priestley Leach is to donate a Silver Birch Tree to the village in memory of her husband.

Letter received from Shirley Dalby regarding History Group monies. It is agreed that the monies referred to remain in the SVA account and will be ring fenced for the History Group. A letter was received from the Swanland Bowling Club thanking the SVA for its support by printing articles in the Newsletter and providing funds to purchase a new bench. The Club has requested the insertion of a leaflet in the Spring Edition of the Newsletter. This was agreed by the Committee and **AC agreed to liaise with the Bowling Club. YF to email confirmation.**

The Bowling Club also requested whether funding was available for a second bench. It was agreed that the SVA will match fund a second bench. YD proposed and SK seconded. **YF to email confirmation.**
